A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT'S FIBERNET FOR THE PROVISION OF ADDING THE CITY OF DORAL TRAILS AND TAILS PARK TO THE CITY'S WIDE AREA NETWORK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000.00 PER YEAR FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral wide area network, which provides Ethernet services, includes City Hall, the Police building, Morgan Levy Park, Doral Meadow Park, and the NAP of the Americas; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Florida Power and Light's FiberNet for the provision of adding the City of Doral Trails and Tails Park to the City's wide area network in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00 per year for a period of three (3) years.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Florida Power and Light's FiberNet for the provision of adding the City of Doral Trails and Tails Park to the City's wide area network in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00 per year for a period of three (3) years.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
