## **RESOLUTION Z05-16**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA APPROVING THE FINAL PLAT OF THE ISLANDS AT DORAL - DORAL ISLES NORTH SECTION THREE, GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF NW 114 PLACE AND NW 82 STREET, MIAMIDADE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR RECORDATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE
