A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF THE COMPUTER-AIDED DISPATCH (CAD) SYSTEM WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY CONTRACT NO. BW9745-3/25 AND SUNGARD AGREEMENT NO. 080104, RESOLUTION NO. 08-25, INCLUSIVE OF A ONE-TIME COST IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$91,173.00 AND AN ANNUAL RECURRING COST OF \$12,758.00 FOR AS LONG AS THE CAD INTEGRATION WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY IS UTILIZED BY THE DORAL POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Police Department strives to provide the best technology for our community, business owners and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the proposed solution is expected to provide a unified system that will maximize operational efficiencies across the City of Doral leading to increased situational awareness, improved first responder safety, enhanced interoperability across supporting systems, and ultimately reduce response times. The CAD integration will also improve the safety of our officers by providing accurate location given by the Miami-Dade Police Dispatcher; and

WHEREAS, currently the Doral Police Department Communications Unit mirrors the Miami-Dade Police by typing the audible dispatch information. The Doral Police Department Communications Unit is not integrated with the Miami-Dade Police Departments CAD system. This has created inaccurate response times, inability for call takers and supervisors to view holding calls, and errors in entering calls into our current CAD system; and

WHEREAS, the proposed solution will give the City of Doral the ability to respond to, actively manage, and analyze situations threatening the safety, welfare, and property

of citizens, including public safety enhanced initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the CAD Integration System with the Miami-Dade Police Department Communications Bureau, Motorola Master Agreement Contract no. BW9745-3/25 and Sungard Agreement No. 080104, Resolution No. 08-25. It will be a one-time cost of \$91,173.00 from account 001.22005.500652 between the following vendors: Motorola cost for 125 Licenses in the amount of \$73,750.00, Motorola Data Feed to OSSI Records Management System in the amount of \$8,043.00, OSSI Build Interface in the amount of \$9,380.00 and an annual recurring cost of \$12,758.00 from account 001.22005.500460; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the City Council approve a Resolution authorization for the City Manager to purchase annual licenses and the annual recurring costs in the amount not to exceed the annual budgeted funds for as long as CAD Integration System with Miami-Dade Police Department Communication Bureau is utilized by the Doral Police Department funded in the Information Technology department account 001.22005.500460 Repair and Maintenance Office Equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The foregoing recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Pursuant to section 2-322 of the City Code of Ordinances, the purchase of the CAD with Miami Dade County, Motorola Master Agreement Contract no. BW9745-3/25 and Sungard Agreement No. 080104, Resolution

No. 08-25 in the amount of \$91,173.00 from account number 001.22005.500652 and the annual recurring cost in the amount not to exceed \$12,758.00 from account 001.22005.500460 is hereby approved. The Department further requests that City Council authorizes the annual recurring cost for as long as the CAD Integration with Miami-Dade County is utilized by the Doral Police Department.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Authorization.</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement and other contractual documents, subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
