

RESOLUTION No. 22-138

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A WORK ORDER WITH BCC ENGINEERING, LLC. TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AND UPDATE THE 2019 STORMWATER VULNERABILITY STUDY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$164,989.30; AUTHORIZING A BUDGET TRANSFER OF \$65,000.00 FROM ACCOUNT No. 401.80005.500650 TO ACCOUNT No. 401.80005.500314 TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT FUNDING FOR THIS EFFORT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, On February 12, 2020, the Mayor and City Councilmembers adopted Resolution No. 20-35 (approved 3-0, 2 absentee) adopting the 2019 Stormwater Vulnerability Study (SVS) which evaluated the City of Doral Stormwater Infrastructure and the impacts to the infrastructure due to climate change; and

WHEREAS, the City will expand the SVS to meet the requirements of FS Section 380.093(3)(c) and include the entire City and all critical assets owned and/or maintained by the city and expand on the planning horizon to include Years 2040 and 2070; and

WHEREAS, BCC Engineering, LLC prepared the attached proposal on a lump sum basis with a not to exceed amount of \$164,989.30; and

WHEREAS, BCC Engineering, LLC is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in the December 2020 via Resolution 20-243; and

WHEREAS, the work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between BCC

Engineering, LLC and the City of Doral dated January 4, 2021, and the attached Proposal dated June 09, 2022; and

WHEREAS, staff respectfully requests authorization for the City Manager to execute Work Order No. 7 for BCC Engineering, LLC to provide professional engineering design services for the provision of updating the 2019 Stormwater Vulnerability Study to meet the new State requirements per s. 380.093, F.S in an amount not to exceed \$164,989.30, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit “A”; and

WHEREAS, staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Councilmembers authorize The City Manager to transfer \$65,000.00 from Account No. 401.80005.500650 to Account No. 401.80005.500314, to provide for sufficient funding for this services; and

WHEREAS, Funding for this Work Order is available in the current Fiscal Year in the Public Works Stormwater Fund – “Professional Services-Engineer”, Account No. 401.80005.500314.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Approval. The work order between the City and BCC Engineering, LLC to provide professional engineering services to update the 2019 Stormwater Vulnerability Study in an amount not to exceed \$164,989.30 as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order with BCC Engineering, LLC and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City in furtherance hereof. The City Manager is further authorized to transfer \$65,000.00 from Account No. 401.80005.500650 to Account No. 401.80005.500314.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Mariaca who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Cabral and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

The City of Doral authorizes the firm of BCC Engineering, LLC to provide professional engineering design services for the provision of updating the 2019 Stormwater Vulnerability Study to meet the new State requirements per s. 380.093, F.S. Where BCC Engineering, Inc. is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in October 2020 through Resolution 20-243. The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Agreement between BCC Engineering, LLC and the City of Doral dated January 4, 2021, and the attached Proposal dated June 09, 2022 and submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCEHDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from BCC Engineering, LLC dated June 09, 2022, for the update to the 2019 Stormwater Vulnerability Study. The schedule requires the scoped of work to be completed within twelve (12) months after Notice to Proceed is provided. All limitations of time set forth in this Work Order are of the essence. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a lump sum basis not to exceed the amount of \$164,989.30.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal and revoke the award.

Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated January 4, 2021, between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply. Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement on the day and date first above written, in three (3) counterparts, each of which shall, without proof or accounting for the other counterpart be deemed an original Contract.
