

RESOLUTION No. 24-183

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER WITH GPE ENGINEERING & GENERAL CONTRACTORS CORP. FOR THE PROVISION OF STORM DRAIN AND RIGHT-OF-WAY REPAIR SERVICES ALONG NW 35 LANE BETWEEN NW 87 AVENUE AND 89 COURT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$156,612.50; WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR ANY UNFORESEEN CONDITIONS; RECOGNIZING THAT GPE ENGINEERING & GENERAL CONTRACTORS CORP. IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2022, the existing contract for “Milling, Resurfacing and Miscellaneous Stormwater and Roadway Improvement” (ITB-2019-12) expired; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department (PWD) proceeded to fragment the all-encompassing scope of work of previous contract to its new format of three (3) “scope specific” areas of construction; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2022, Request for Qualification (RFQ) No. 2022-14 “Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services” was issued and advertised on the City’s Website; and

WHEREAS, a recommendation was made by the committee to award the top four (4) ranked firms, David Mancini & Sons, Giannetti Contracting Corp., GPE Engineering and General Contractors, and Ric-Man International Inc., establishing a Pool of Construction Firms for “Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services”; and

WHEREAS, the PWD needs to secure a firm to provide Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services along NW 35th Lane between NW 87th Avenue and 89th Court; and

WHEREAS, the PWD requested a proposal from the “Pre-Qualified” Pool of Contractors to provide “Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services” along NW 35th Lane between NW 87th Avenue and 89th Court; and

WHEREAS, GPE Engineering & General Contractors Corp. (GPE) provided attached proposal with a not to exceed amount of One Hundred Fifty Six Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars and 50/100 (\$156,612.50), which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen.; and

WHEREAS, the contract between GPE and the City of Doral was procured through the publicly advertised Request for Qualification (RFQ) 2022-14 process to select a pool of pre-qualified Construction Services firms for “Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services” projects; and

WHEREAS, this group of four (4) firms was approved by the City Council during the August 2022 Council meeting via Resolution No. 22-145; and

WHEREAS, City staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Councilmembers approve Work Order No. 4 for “Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services” along NW 35th Lane between NW 87th Avenue and 89th Court to GPE, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Six Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars and 50/100 (\$156,612.50); and

WHEREAS, funding for this request is available from the Stormwater Fund – Account Num. 401.80005.500650.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Work Order No. 4 for “Storm Drain and Right-of-Way Repair Services” along NW 35th Lane between NW 87th Avenue and 89th Court, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Six Thousand Six Hundred Twelve Dollars and 50/100 (\$156,612.50), which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”, together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Pineyro who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Puig-Corve and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
