A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF NW 34 STREET FROM NW 79 AVENUE TO NW 77 COURT AS "STEPHEN MUSOLINO WAY"; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**WHEREAS**, the City of Doral adopted Ordinance 2008-15 and established a policy for the naming, re-naming or co-designating of City streets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral received an application for the co-designation of NW 34<sup>th</sup> Street between NW 79th Avenue and NW 77<sup>th</sup> Court as "Stephen Musolino Way"; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Doral Public Works Department has evaluated the application and verified that all of the Ordinance requirements have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the application is being sponsored by Mayor Juan Carlos Bermudez; and

**WHEREAS**, City Staff respectfully request that the City Council approve the co-designation of NW 34<sup>th</sup> Street between NW 79<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 77<sup>th</sup> Court as "Stephen Musolino Way"; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The application for the co-designation of NW 34th

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Street between NW 79<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 77<sup>th</sup> Court as "Stephen Musolino Way", a copy of the application which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved inclusive of waiving of the \$1,000.00 application fee.

**Section 3. Authorization.** The City Manager is authorized to approve the codesignation application on behalf of the City.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

Stephen Musolino was born in Reggio Calabria, Italy. He married his wife Anne in 1957 and sailed to New York where he became a proud American citizen. They were married for 60 years until she passed just 9 weeks before his death.

He was a loving husband and father of 5. His passions were mostly his business and golfing.

He is survived by 4 of his children, 13 grandchildren and 2 great-grandchildren.

In 1974 he moved his family to Miami to start a business of his own. He soon became a pioneer in the Italian ceramic tile industry.

His products took so well to the market that at one point he had 9 offices through the US, Canada and Puerto Rico shipping tile directly to distributors from Italy and other countries.

He is loved and well respected by many people still in the industry today, many of whom he helped get them started.

He started a retail store Casa Linda Tile & Marble, still operating in the same location for over 30 years. Now owned and managed by his son Stephen Jr.

He passed away peacefully on July 14, 2017 with his children by his side.

He will be greatly miss by his family, friend, colleagues, all of whom had greatly benefited from knowing and loving him.

He chose for his marble and tile distribution a location that is now Doral. Many of his customers set up shops nearby as well buying tiles, marble and window sills from him and directly from Italy with him as the agent for the factories abroad.

He was the first one to bring ceramic tiles from Italy to the United States.

The competition grew as many dealers and retail stores opened in Doral as well, creating what many people through the United States now known as the Tile District on 79<sup>th</sup> Ave. Other business have evolved in this area to complement the tile industry creating what we now know as the Doral Décor District.

# Public Works Department Procedures for Naming, Renaming or Co-designating Streets

Purpose.
To outline the policy, criteria, and process for naming, renaming or co-designating certain streets in the City of Doral.  Policy
The City Council shall approve by resolution the naming, renaming or co-designation of any street in the City of Doral upon receiving a recommendation from the Public Works Department (PWD).
Procedures for Naming, Renaming or Co-designation  ———————————————————————————————————
The PWD will review all proposals for adherence to the stated criteria and will submit a recommendation to the City Manager and City Council. The City Council will review all applications for the following information:  • clearly show that approving the request would be consistent with the criteria provided below in this policy  • demonstrate written public support for the proposed name.
The application will describe the contributions made to the City by the person, organization or corporation after whom a City street is to be named (nominee) and will describe why the specific naming proposal is appropriate. The City Council shall make a final determination on granting or denying an application. In doing so, the City Council shall have absolute discretion to grant or deny the application. All applications for naming a City of Doral Street shall require a majority vote of the City Council to be approved. The City Commission may exempt itself from these procedures or waive these guidelines upon finding a public purpose.
Criteria for Streets
The following criteria will be considered when selecting a name:
Recommendation should be sponsored by an Elected Official of the City of Doral: Wayon 50 Benutial

Consideration shall be given to whether there is historical significance, geographical identifiers, and/or natural characteristics.

and/or other services considered extraordinary or long term in nature.

The person, organization or corporation after whom a municipal street is to be named (nominee) shall have made a significant contribution to the community, thereby furthering the community's good name and image. The contribution may demonstrate achievement through volunteerism, leadership, financial assistance

Consideration shall also be given as to whether the nominee has already had sites named after him/her. Names should not be a duplicate of another street within Doral to avoid confusion.
The City has final approval on the design and placement of markers on City streets.
Names should not imply support for discrimination, or be considered derogatory or socially unacceptable.
No naming will be considered that diminishes the historic integrity of a requested street.
The applicant will obtain the signature of a majority of the owners of properties, which abut, the affected street on a petition in support.
Consideration shall be given to whether the request will segment a specific street.
Consideration shall be given to whether the requested street currently has an existing co-designation.
Requests are ineligible when a similar request was considered and declined by the City within three years of the date of submittal of the current application.
Requests are ineligible when the street has previously been renamed within 10 years of the date of submittal of the current application.
Resolution honoring outstanding individuals shall not be authorized for living individuals except as provided below.
The rule shall not prohibit the naming, renaming or designation of a street after a living individual who donates a significant portion of the cost of such street. Further this rule should not prohibit the naming or codesignation of a street after a living individual who has made a direct, significant lifetime contribution to this community, provided;
That the naming, renaming or co-designation is approved by three votes of the City Council present;
That the naming, renaming or co-designation is not for any elected municipal, county, state or federal official currently serving or having served in any elected office within the last five years.
Notification for Street Names
Notification regarding the name change shall be mailed, by the City, to all the residents within one mile of the affected street.
Notification shall be mailed, by the City, to the owners of all properties adjacent or addressed from the affected street.
Notification shall be advertised, by the City, in the local newspaper a minimum of 10 days prior to the City Council meeting consideration or as noted. Notification shall include the request, location, time and date of the meeting.
The effected street shall be posted, by the City, for a minimum of 10 days prior to consideration by the City Council at the beginning and end of the affected street and between these two points, at intervals of not more than 1,000 feet.

#### The following corridors are not eligible for consideration:

All main roads that are under Miami-Dade County Jurisdiction:

NW 12th, 25th, 36th/41st, 58th Streets and NW 87th, 97th and 107th Avenues.

#### **Un-designation of a Street:**

If an individual is convicted of any felony, guilt of any crime involving moral turpitude, or for any other possible purpose as determined by City Council, the street shall be un-designated.

#### Maximum applications per year:


A Maximum of two co-designations shall be allowed per calendar year.

#### Maximum distance of raod:

The maximum distance of any single co-designation shall be I mile.
