QUALIFYING INFORMATION

City of Doral City Charter, Section 2.04 "Qualifications:"

"Candidates for Councilmember or Mayor shall qualify for election by filing a written notice of candidacy with the City Clerk at such time and in such manner as may be prescribed by ordinance (the "Qualifying Date") and payment of a qualifying fee of \$200 to the City Clerk. A person may not be a candidate for Councilmember and Mayor in the same election. Only electors of the City who have resided continuously in the City for at least two years preceding their Qualifying Date shall be eligible to hold the office of Councilmember or Mayor. If at the conclusion of the qualifying period no elector has filed or qualified for the position of Mayor or a particular Seat, then the qualifying period for Mayor or for that particular Seat shall be reopened for a period of five business days for qualification in the manner provided in this Section."

Qualifying as a Candidate:

All candidates for the municipal election must qualify **in person** with the City Clerk by visiting the Office of the City Clerk at City of Doral City Hall.

All candidates for municipal office must qualify with the City Clerk during the **Qualifying Period**.

In order to qualify the following will be necessary:

- Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository for Candidates (DS DE 9)
- Statement of Candidate (DS DE 84)
- Candidate Oath (DS-DE 302 NP)
- Voluntary Declaration for Candidates
- FORM 1
- Voter Registration Card
- Proof of residency in the City of Doral for two (2) years prior to qualifying.
- **Qualifying fee of \$200.00**
- **Sign bond** in the amount of **\$500.00**
- **Fee of \$120.00 for Candidates for Council seats or \$500.00 for Candidates for Mayor Seat** which will be forwarded to the Florida Elections Commission for deposit into the Election Commission Trust Fund (F.S. 99.093)
 - The Sign Bond, the Qualifying Fee, and the Fee for the Election Commission Trust Fund are payable to the City of Doral and provided to the City Clerk at the time of qualification.
Note: funds must be drawn from the candidate's campaign account.
