A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE POSITION OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION THAT THE STATE OF FLORIDA AND APPLICABLE LEGISLATIVE AND EXECUTIVE OFFICIALS TAKE ALL MEASURES TO ALLOW APPLICANTS TO APPLY FOR REEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS RETROACTIVELY TO THE DATE THE APPLICANT LOST HIS/HER JOB FOLLOWING THE DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY BY THE FLORIDA GOVERNOR; AND FURTHER RESOLVING THAT IT SUPPORTS ALL REEMPLOYMENT MEASURES RECOMMENDED BY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION IN THEIR APRIL 7, 2020 LETTER TO FLORIDA GOVERNOR RON DESANTIS; PROVIDING FOR TRANSMITTAL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis declared a State of Emergency as of March in the State of Florida due to the Corona Virus (COVID-19) and;

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 has decimated the economy of Florida including, without limitation, the commercial, hospitality, service, restaurants, bars, sales, and manufacturing sector and trades, and;

WHEREAS, during this pandemic occurring within our state, the Miami-Dade Legislative Delegation advised Florida Governor DeSantis to retroactively provide assistance to applicants of reemployment to the date when they lost their job.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Support.</u> The Mayor and City Council for the City of Doral hereby support the Miami-Dade Legislative Delegation's letter urging Governor Ron DeSantis to
