

RESOLUTION NO. 04-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA; RECOGNIZING THE CONTINUED EXISTENCE AND EXTENDING THE SUNSET PROVISION FOR THE COMMUNITY IDENTITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 10, 2003, the Mayor and City Council (the "Council") of the City of Doral (the "City") adopted Resolution No 03-27 (the "Resolution") creating the Community Identify Advisory Committee (the "Committee"); and

WHEREAS, the Resolution provided that the Committee would sunset 150 days after adoption; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council wish to extend the prior Resolution's sunset provision for an additional sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. **Sunset.** The Committee continues to exist and shall sunset sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Resolution. The Committee shall prepare a written report containing its activities and recommendations through that period.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Ruiz, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Cabrera and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
