

**RESOLUTION NO. 10- 142**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA ESTABLISHING A MILLAGE RATE OF 2.447 MILLS, WHICH IS 7.252% LOWER THAN THE ROLLED-BACK RATE TO BALANCE THE GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010-2011; ESTABLISHING THE ROLLED-BACK RATE TO BE 2.63833 MILLS; AND ESTABLISHING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22, 2010 AS THE DATE THAT A FINAL PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD AT 5:01 P.M. AT THE CITY OF DORAL, CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, 8300 NW 53<sup>RD</sup> STREET, SUITE 100, DORAL FLORIDA 33166; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Doral (the "City") is required to establish, pursuant to State law, a millage rate to balance the budget for the General Fund for Fiscal Year 2010-2011; and

**WHEREAS**, in furtherance of State law, the City has confirmed its rolled-back rate and established a time and place for a public hearing on the City's millage rate and budget;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. That the City Council establishes a millage rate of \$2.447 per \$1,000.00 of assessed property value within the City of Doral, to balance the budget for the General Fund for Fiscal Year 2010-2011, and establishes Wednesday, September 22, 2010 at 5:01 pm, as the date and time of a final public hearing when the City Council will receive comments from the public regarding the proposed budget and proposed millage rate.

Section 2. That the City Council further confirms the rolled-back rate for the 2010-2011 Fiscal Year to be 2.63833 mills. The actual millage rate of 2.447 mills is 7.252% less than the rolled back rate.

Section 3. That the City Council further establishes the place and time of said public hearing to be the City of Doral, City Hall Council Chambers, located at 8300 N.W. 53<sup>rd</sup> Street, Doral, FL 33166 at 5:01 P.M..

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilman DiPietro who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Van Name and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
