Summary of the proposed ordinance and statement of public purpose¹:

The public purpose of this Ordinance is for the City of Doral to prohibit the use of Styrofoam by those in City parks as well as restrict the sale/use of some polystyrene articles by vendors in City parks in an effort to be more environmentally friendly.

a. Estimate of direct compliance costs that businesses may reasonably incur if the proposed ordinance is enacted:

Water

-Dasani Water: Plastic Bottle (16.9 FL OZ 32 pack)- \$6.98 vs. Aluminum bottle (16 FL OZ 8

pack)- \$38.95

Estimated Increase: \$31.97

Address the public purpose to be served by the proposed ordinance, such as serving the public health, safety, morals, and welfare of the City of Doral.



Other caned water options (for reference):

-Proud Source Water- 16oz Bottles (6 pack) = \$19.49

-JUST water- 11.2 FL OZ (24 pack) = \$31.40

-Boxed Water- 8.5oz (24 pack) \$29.00 (unable to go inside vending machines)

Gatorade

-Plastic Bottles (12FL OZ 24 pack)- \$13.53 vs. Cans (11.6 oz 12 pack)- \$29.43

Estimated Increase: \$15.90

Utensils

-Regular plastic cutlery combo (192 count)- \$14.39 vs. 100% Compostable Cutlery combo (380)- \$55.98

Estimated Increase: \$41.59

Other utensil options (for reference):

- 200 Agave (Greenprint) cutlery combo- \$62.99
- -389 Bamboo cutlery combo set- \$58.50
- -1000 Bamboo drink stirrers- \$11.54
 - b. Identification of any new charges or fee on businesses subject to the proposed ordinance, or for which businesses will be financially responsible; and

Will need to comply with ordinance by providing alternatives to plastic utensils, Styrofoam items and plastic bottles (when available). The business will be solely responsible for these added costs to provide these items.
