## Camping Under the Stars & Movie Night

### Camping Rules & Regulations:

- NO ALCOHOLIC beverages will be allowed.
- NO SMOKING.
- If bringing a quick shade tent, tents larger than 10X10 will not be permitted. Tents must be placed a minimum of 5ft away from neighboring tents.
- Grills and BBQ's will not be permitted in the campsite.
- Pets ARE NOT permitted.
- Pre-registration forms are available on-line. Pre-registration will end on Thursday, January 25<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm. On-site registration will begin on Friday, January 26<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 pm and will be on a first come, first serve basis. Everyone, including those that pre-registered, must check-in on the event date. **Once registered, camping groups will be assigned a number to place on the outside of the tent.**
- **Registration for overnight stay will end promptly at 8:30pm. After this time, no one will be able to register and must vacate the park by lights out at 11:00pm. Only those that are properly registered with be allowed to stay overnight.**
- Check-in and Camping Gear set-up will begin at 3:00 pm on Friday, January 26<sup>th</sup>. **Vehicles will be allowed to park in a designated unloading area until 5:30pm, at which point vehicles must be moved to General Parking. If a group arrives after 5:30 pm, they must carry their camping items from the General Parking area to the site. No vehicles will be allowed on the campsite at any time.**
- **Upon Check-in, the adult identified as the “Responsible Party” of the group, and any 21 yr. old adult, will be required to show PICTURE ID before collecting their tent number and wristbands. All members of the party must be present at the check-in table with their “Responsible Party” in order to collect their wristband. “Responsible Party” individuals must remain for the duration of the event with the group they are responsible for.**
- Those without wristbands will be escorted out of the event.
- Only vendors and organizations authorized by the City of Doral Parks & Recreation Department will be permitted to sell food and beverages.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.
- Generators will not be provided and will not be permitted.
- Children around the camp fire need to be supervised at all times.
- Flying objects for the use of sport (football, baseballs, softballs, kicking balls, Frisbees, etc.) will not be permitted in the center of the camp site circle.
- Dispose of all trash in the proper containers.
- Those under the age of 21 will not be allowed to camp overnight unless accompanied by an adult over the age of 25.
- City staff reserves the right to remove those engaged in misconduct and not in full compliance of all aforementioned rules and regulations.
