A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ADA ENGINEERING INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF DESIGN SERVICES FOR CANAL STABILIZATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$197,143.00; RECOGNIZING THAT ADA ENGINEERING, INC., IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Canal Capital Improvement Program (CCIP) will improve the canal system within the city; and

WHEREAS, City of Doral Resolution #2007-89 pre-qualified ten (10) vendors, including ADA Engineering, Inc. (ADA), to provide services needed for capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, in moving forward with the design phase of the critical areas identified in the CCIP, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with ADA for the provision of design services for canal stabilization in an amount not to exceed \$197,143.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with ADA for the provision of design services for canal stabilization in an amount not to exceed \$197,143.00.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
