

RESOLUTION No. 20-45

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH AXON ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF 160 TASER 7 AND FOUR (4) YEAR WARRANTIES FROM THE POLICE IMPACT FEES/CAPITAL OUTLAY OFFICE ACCOUNT No. 103.60005.500640 AND THE CAPITAL OUTLAY- GENERAL ACCOUNT No. 001.6005.500640 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$536,120.00; RECOGNIZING THAT AXON ENTERPRISES, INC. IS SOLE-SOURCE VENDOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department requests to purchase 160 Taser 7 and four (4) year warranties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department has deployed low lethal electronic control weapons (TASERs) since 2008. TASERs are used in confrontational situations with combative suspects to assert control while reducing the risk of injury of officers and/or suspects; and

WHEREAS, presently, the City of Doral Police Department has three (3) different generations of Tasers in use and each model has its own specific capabilities and limitations. In order to standardize the Department's training, while providing a more effective device, the Training Unit is requesting approval to purchase the Taser 7, which is currently the most advanced and effective model available today. The purchase will also include field and training cartridges, battery docking stations, a five-year warranty, and other accessories to equip all officers. The advanced performance of Taser 7 makes for greater confidence in the field through its enhanced short - and long-range capabilities to neutralize a violent attacker or suicidal person. Taser 7 darts fly straighter and faster

with nearly twice the kinetic energy for better connection to the target, and 93% increased probe spread at close range. The new Taser also provides a more rapid incapacitation and improved daylight target acquisition because of its new green daylight laser. The enhanced connection to the Axon network unlocks streamlined workflows. The Taser 7 management system allows for the assigning of devices and accessories in seconds with the Axon Device Manager application, and update firmware, upload logs and recharge the battery simply by docking it. The new batteries also require less recharging due to increased capability. The Taser 7 is completely integrated into Axon's [Evidence.com](https://www.evidence.com), the company's cloud-based system that stores the entire Department's data from body-worn cameras to audio records, while streamlining data management and sharing.

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council to negotiate and enter with AXON Enterprises, Inc. which is a sole source vendor for the purchase of 160- Taser 7 and four (4) year warranties. This purchase is funded from the Police Impact Fees-Capital Outlay, #103.60005.500640 in an amount of \$18,000.00 as Year 1A and Years 1B through Year 5 from Capital Outlay- General Account #001.6005.500640 in an amount of \$518,120.00 giving us a grand total of \$536,120.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Manager is hereby authorizing the purchase of 160 Taser 7 and four (4) warranties from AXON Enterprises, Inc. which is a sole source

vendor. This purchase is funded from the Police Impact Fees-Capital Outlay, #103.60005.500640 in an amount of \$18,000.00 as Year 1A and Years 1B through Year 5 from Capital Outlay- General Account #001.6005.500640 in an amount of \$518,120.00 giving us a grand total of \$536,120.00.
