

RESOLUTION No. 15-64

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, REVISING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE CITY OF DORAL PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the “City”) Parks & Recreation Department (the “Department”) is currently offering sports, recreation programs and events pursuant to the fee schedule set by the Department and service providers and approved by the City Council in 2013; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the existing fees, the Department has identified minor changes that should be made to the schedule of programming and special event fees; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the City Council adopt the fee schedule for the City of Doral Parks & Recreation Department as presented in Exhibit “A”, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Approval of Recreation Fees. The fee schedule for the City of Doral Parks and Recreation Department, as presented in Exhibit “A”, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
