A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND RENAISSANCE ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL TO ASSIST IN THE PREVENTION OF JUVENILE DELINQUENCY THROUGH THE PROVISIONS OF THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City has established a School Resource Officer (SRO) Program pursuant to applicable Florida law. In order to meet the requirements imposed by the Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School Public Safety (MSDHS) Act and specifically the provisions of Fla. Stat. 1006.12, the school desires that the City provide a law enforcement officer to serve as its School Resource Officer (hereinafter "SRO") at the school; and

WHEREAS, the City and school understand and agree that the SRO Program is established for the assistance in the prevention of juvenile delinquency through the provisions of programs specifically developed to respond to those factors and condition that give rise to delinquency; and

WHEREAS, the school shall pay the City the sum of seventy one thousand sixty dollars (\$71,060.00) per school year for the SRO assigned by the City under the Term of the Agreement, which shall be paid in (10) equal installments of seven thousand one hundred six dollars (\$7,106.00) on the first of each month (September, 2019 to June, 2020).

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the City Council approve the School Resource Officer Agreement between the City of Doral and Renaissance Elementary/Middle School to assist in the prevention of juvenile delinquency through the provisions of the program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the School Resource Officer Agreement on behalf of the City subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
