# **Economic Development Division**





- The Economic Development division promotes the City of Doral as a business-friendly destination and assists businesses interested in opening in, relocating to, or expanding their operations in Doral.
- The division generates actionable leads to attract and assist new-to-market businesses from an intelligence network that includes important regional Economic Development organizations like The Beacon Council and Select Florida, as well as business organizations, investment advisors, partner institutions, lenders, realtors, residents, and stakeholders.

#### **Business Orientation**







The division offers individualized business assistance consultations to any business interested in doing business in, or with, the City of Doral. One-on-one meetings and site visits with new-to-market and existing businesses provide an opportunity to deliver reliable information, business support services and targeted referrals tailored to the needs of each business.

#### **Business Assistance and Grants**









- Community Based Organizations (CBO) Grant non-profit grant up to \$5K
- Façade Improvement Grant Program 50% property improvement grant up to \$10K
- PTSA Educational Grants annual educational enhancement grant for Doral PTSAs up to max \$6K
- Business Valuations Program free business valuation analysis for eligible Doral firms, a \$5K value
- **Doral Spend Local, Save Local program** promotional video campaign encouraging local businesses to offer discount to residents
- Best of the Best Surveys promotional campaign where residents vote for their favorite local businesses in a different category each month
- Prospera's "Stand Up Doral For Small Business" Program partnership with
   Prospera providing no-cost mentoring for local firms

The division partners with a wide range of economic development and educational institutions that can help businesses to grow and thrive at no cost to the business.



#### **Business Education**









Doral collaborates with institutions like Miami Dade College, StartUp FIU, Millenia Atlantic University, The Greater Miami Convention & Visitors Bureau, Grow with Google, Miami Bayside Foundation, the Goldman Sachs 10K Small Businesses program, the Federal Reserve and the US Department of Commerce on business education programs, trainings, and seminars to help stimulate small business growth.

#### **Expos & Conferences**









The division participates in international business expos, conferences and workshops, including the eMerge Americas tech conference and the Hemispheric Congress. The Economic Development division also hosts regional and national activities in partnership with federal agencies such as the US Small Business Administration and the US Department of Commerce.

## International Relations







The division works with global partners to broaden economic opportunities and stimulate investment. The division administers Doral's Sister Cities program and coordinates diplomatic visits, consular relations, trade missions and cultural activities with organizations like AmCham, consulates and trade agencies. Doral has active Sister Cities agreements with Armenia and Barranquilla, Colombia; Guatemala City, Guatemala; Higuey, Dominican Republic; Oranjestad, Aruba; and the Xixhi District of New Taipei City, Taiwan.

### **Ribbon-Cutting Events**






The division works with the business owner and the City of Doral Licensing division to ensure that the applicant is ready to open their doors before the ribbon-cutting.

# **Good News: Telling the Doral story**





Now 20 years old, Doral has blossomed into an international logistics center for Greater Miami - and a vibrant city in its own right.

When Ramon Mareno launched his fish importing company west of Miami International Airport 25 years ago, the area was a sparsely settled swath of unincoprotated Miami-Dade County, Like other businesses in the area, he was attracted by low land cost and proximity to the airport. He started with a small warehouse and truck, then opened a fish market, and then expanded to a larger warehouse.

Fast forward to today. Mareno's Heads or Tails Inc. now offen 250 diseases types of fresh, frozen, and salted seafood products from Nicaragua, Ecuador, Goattemala, Mexico, Panama, Costa Rica, Venezuela, Tinisidad, Turkey, Chile, Indonesia, Canada, and Norway — all coming to Miami then redistributed throughout the United States. His warehouse has grown to 15,000 square feet, with cold storage capabilities.




