The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a Time and Materials basis with a not to exceed amount of \$5,000.00.



In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply. This Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

Civil Engineering Services have been requested of BCC Engineering, LLC (BCC) to assist with the Legacy Park – Interactive Water Feature project. BCC will provide Services after receipt of this written authorization.

BCC will provide the following service task(s) on an hourly basis at the rates indicated in the Master Agreement:

- Assist in coordination between agencies having jurisdiction, namely Florida Department of Health, to expedite the closing of the existing permit for the Interactive Water feature.
- Review of as-built information and provide recommendations to close out permit.
- Attendance to any coordination meetings or site visits is included as part of this task.

Assumptions and/or Exclusions

- Client shall perform any required revisions to plans, sketches, specifications.
- Client to provide any necessary documentation (forms, as-builts, certifications) for permit closure.
- No design services are included in these services.
- Client shall pay regulatory fees related to plan review, permit issuance, re-work, printing and time extensions out of BCC's control.
