

RESOLUTION No. 09 – 170

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE N.W. 33RD STREET WIDENING DESIGN/BUILD PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$131,288.00; RECOGNIZING THAT MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC. IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral seeks to continuously improve roadways within the City; and

WHEREAS, City of Doral Resolution #2007 – 89 pre-qualified ten (10) vendors, including Marlin Engineering, Inc. (Marlin) to provide services needed for capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Marlin for the provision of Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI) services for the N.W. 33rd Street widening design/build project in an amount not to exceed \$131,288.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Marlin for the provision of CEI services for the N.W. 33rd Street widening design/build project in an amount not to exceed \$131,288.00.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
