A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA WAIVING THE REQUIREMENT FOR AN APPRAISAL AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SONOMA TOWNHOMES AT DORAL COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC, A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, FOR THE PURCHASE OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT N.W. 114TH AVENUE AND N.W. 50TH STREET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral actively searches for sites that maximize the park and open space areas for our residents; and

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to enter into an agreement for the purchase and sale of 10 acres of real property from Sonoma Townhomes at Doral Community Association, inc. for a purchase price of \$10.00; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council waive the requirement for an appraisal and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Sonoma Townhomes at Doral Community Association, Inc. for the purchase of property located at N.W. 114th Avenue and N.W. 50th Street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council hereby waives the requirement for an appraisal and authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Sonoma Townhomes at Doral Community Association, Inc. for the purchase of property located at N.W. 114th Avenue and N.W. 50th Street.
