## **ORDINANCE** #2010 – 22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN ENCUMBRANCE CARRYFORWARD AMENDMENT INCREASING THE GENERAL FUNDS BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010; INCREASING THE TRANSPORTATION FUNDS BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010 AND INCREASING THE STORMWATER FUNDS BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") finds it necessary to adjust certain budget line items in the City's General Funds, Transportation and Storm Water Budget for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 (the "Budget");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The General Fund Budget is hereby amended and increased in the amount of \$1,743,849 by the inclusion of and appropriation by line items pursuant to exhibit I. The Transportation Fund Budget is hereby amended and increased in the amount of \$526,481 by the inclusion of and appropriation by line items pursuant to exhibit II. The Storm Water Fund Budget is hereby amended and increased in the amount of \$1,027,687 by the inclusion of and appropriation by line items pursuant to exhibit III.

Pursuant to Article IV Section 4.06 of the City Charter whereby a supplemental appropriation is being made from Reserved for Encumbrance Fund Balances as per the 2009 Audited Financial Statement.

General Fund.

Section 2. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections,

sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption on second reading.

The foregoing Ordinance was offered by Councilwoman Ruiz, who moved its adoption.
