

RESOLUTION NO. 13-137

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE TO THE EXISTING PURCHASE ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND DORAL LINCOLN MERCURY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000.00 (TOTAL AMOUNT OF PURCHASE ORDER NOT TO EXCEED \$45,000.00) FOR VEHICLE MAINTENANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral, Florida has issued RFP #2013-27 titled “Non-Warranty Vehicle Maintenance and Repair;” however, until a contract is awarded to a vendor the Doral Police Department’s vehicles need to be regularly serviced and maintained; and

WHEREAS, the City has an existing purchase order with Doral Lincoln Mercury for police vehicle service and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, due to the age of the Police Department’s vehicle fleet and corresponding service and maintenance needs, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize an increase of \$30,000.00 to the existing purchase order with Doral Lincoln Mercury in a total amount not to exceed \$45,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true, correct, and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Authorization. The City Council hereby authorizes an increase of \$30,000.00 to the existing purchase order with Doral Lincoln Mercury in a total amount not to exceed \$45,000.00 for the continued service and maintenance of the Police Department’s vehicle fleet.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Fraga who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Rodriguez and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
