The work should be performed in accordance with the contract provisions contained in the Continuing Professional Services Final Agreement between BCC Engineering, Inc. and the City of Doral dated February 2, 2015, and the attached Proposal dated January 15, 2018 and submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES AND SCEHDULE:

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal from BCC Engineering, Inc. for the Street Tree Inventory Services. The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and materials basis with a not to exceed amount of \$27,400.

You are required by the Continuing Service Agreement to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, or as directed otherwise. If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal, and revoke the award.

This Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated February 2, 2015 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply.

Work Order is not binding until the City of Doral agrees and approves this Work Order.

RESOLUTION No.17-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURSUE THE NATIONAL URBAN AND COMMUNITY FORESTRY GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING UP TO \$50,000.00 IN MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE GRANT; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") recognizes the importance and the benefits that trees provide to our community; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to pursue grant funds to enhance our urban tree canopy, by conducting a citywide tree canopy inventory and developing an Urban Tree Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has recommended that the City Council approve budgeting matching funds up to \$50,000 for FY 2017-18, if grant funding is awarded to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Manager is authorized to pursue the National Urban and Community Forestry Grant Program.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to apply for the grant funding and budget \$50,000 in matching funds under the Public Works Department FY 2017-18 General Fund if the City is awarded the grant funding.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the

purpose and the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Cabrera who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Rodriguez and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


