A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA APPROVING AN OUTDOOR EVENT PERMIT FOR FLAMINGO ROAD CHURCH TO ALLOW FOR A TRUNK OR TREAT EVENT IN THE PARKING LOT OF RONALD W. REAGAN HIGH SCHOOL ON OCTOBER 31ST, 2007 BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 4:30 P.M. TO 9:30 P.M.; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral seeks to support community organizations that benefit the youth of our community; and

WHEREAS; Flamingo Road Church wishes to provide an alternative to traditional Halloween "trick or treating" activities by creating a "Trunk or Treat" outdoor event benefiting the Police Holiday Food Drive; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully recommends that Council approve the proposed Outdoor event permit for an event to take place at the Ronald W. Reagan High School parking lot on October 31st, 2007 with the following conditions:

- Flamingo Road Church is to obtain a letter authorizing the use of the Ronald W.
 Reagan High School parking lot from Miami-Dade County Public Schools.
- 2. The hours of operation are limited from 4:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral, Florida hereby approves the outdoor event permit for Flamingo Road Church's "Trunk or Treat" event subject to the conditions listed in the above "whereas" clause.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
