If you fail to begin work subsequent to the execution of this Work Order, the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal, and revoke the award.

This Work Order incorporates the terms and conditions set forth in the Continuing Services Agreement dated February 26, 2018 between the parties as though fully set forth herein. In the event that any terms or conditions of this Work Order conflict with the Continuing Services Agreement, the provisions of this specific Work Order shall prevail and apply.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO WORK ORDER No. 11 WITH F.R. ALEMAN & ASSOCIATES, INC TO INCREASE THE AVAILABLE FUNDS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES TO COVER THE COST FOR ADDITIONAL DESIGN AND MATERIALS TESTING SERVICES FOR THE DORAL BOULEVARD BUS SHELTER CONCEPT NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE (NOA) PROCESS WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, IN AN AMOUNT OF \$40,040.00 FOR A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$114,598.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AMENDMENT AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in March 2017 the Mayor and City Council adopted the Doral Boulevard Beautification Master Plan serving as the vision and guidance for the future of Doral Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Master Plan recommended the installation of aesthetic bus shelters along Doral Boulevard that are in line with the vision of the corridor as the "Main Street" of the City being a vibrant, active, and pedestrian-oriented environment where residents and visitors can live, shop, and recreate; and

WHEREAS, the PWD in coordination with the Planning and Zoning Department requested that F.R. Aleman and Alleguez Architecture assist in the development of concepts for the proposed bus shelters along Doral Boulevard for Council approval; and

WHEREAS, in August 2019, the Mayor and City Council members approved a resolution selecting Option No. 2 of the three bus shelter concepts presented by the City's consultant F.R. Aleman and their subconsultant Alleguez Architecture; and

WHEREAS, in November 2019, the Mayor and City Council approved Resolution No. 19-293 between the City of Doral and F.R. Aleman and Associates authorizing work

order No. 11 for the design of Option 2 Doral Boulevard Bus Shelter; and

whereas, F.R. Aleman & Associates is a prequalified provider of professional engineering services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act (CCNA) requirements and approved by the City Council in November 2017; and

WHEREAS, the proposal approved per Resolution No. 19-293 did not cover the Notice of Acceptance (NOA) material testing cost and did not include the development of the actual testing documentation and protocol drawings required for Miami-Dade County Bus Shelter's NOA approval.

whereas, F.R. Aleman & Associates provided a proposal dated July 22, 2022, on a time and material basis in a not to exceed amount of \$40,040.00; and

WHEREAS, staff respectfully requests authorization for the City Manager to approve Amendment No. 1 for Work Order 11.1 with F.R. Aleman & Associates to proceed with the development of the testing documentation needed for the Miami-Dade County Bus Shelter's NOA approval, in an amount not to exceed \$40,040.00; and

WHEREAS, the amended Work Order will be in a not to exceed amount of \$114,598.00; and

WHEREAS, staff Funding for this request is available in the Transportation Fund

This First Amendment to F.R. Aleman & Associates, Inc. Work Order No. 11 made and entered into this
WHEREAS, the City of Doral is presently engaged in completing the conceptual design of the Doral Boulevard bus shelters ("Project"); and
WHEREAS, the City of Doral is presently contracted with F.R. Aleman & Associates, Inc. for the provision of professional design services for the development of design plans of the selected conceptual option for the Doral Boulevard bus shelter, and an increase in the Work Order is required to complete the bus shelter Notice of Acceptance process with Miami-Dade County; and
