

RESOLUTION NO. 20-217

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR FY 20-21 FIBRS IMPLEMENTATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SERVICES FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT FOR GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,620.00 (REIMBURSABLE), AND TO EXPEND FUNDS FROM ACCOUNT No. 001.60005.500540 IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,620.00, FOR THE TRANSITIONING OF THE INCIDENT-BASED CRIME DATA REPORTING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department has been awarded \$7,620.00 for FY 20-21 FIBRS Implementation Assistance Program from the Criminal Justice Information Services-Florida Department of Law Enforcement as a reimbursable grant and expend funds from the Dues, Subscription and Membership Account (001.60005.500540) in an amount not to exceed \$7,620.00, which will be used for the transitioning of the incident-based crime data reporting through the FIBRS repository in order to report it to the Federal Bureau of Investigations; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and City Council authorize the application to the FIBRS Implementation Assistance Program for grant funds in the amount of \$7,620.00 as a reimbursable grant and expend funds from the Dues, Subscription and Membership Account (001.60005.500540) in an amount not to exceed \$7,620.00 to be used for the transitioning of the incident-based crime data reporting through the FIBRS repository in order to report it to the Federal Bureau of Investigations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Manager is hereby authorizes the application to the FIBRS Implementation Assistance Program for grant funds in the amount of \$7,620.00 reimbursable grant and expend funds from the Dues, Subscription and Membership Account (001.60005.500540) in the amount of \$7,620.00 to be used for the transitioning of the incident-based crime data reporting through the FIBRS repository in order to report it to the Federal Bureau of Investigations.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
