f. Member's Updates: Silver Club, Military and Youth Advisory Boards, Events **Planning**. We must think about the organization of events with a main theme and around this a program with different activities with guest speakers or special interest to the community.

g. New Business. The individual efforts of this committee volunteers in the rescue, feed, move (kennels) and take care of some animals that live in the streets of the city, require time and money. It is important to have a budget to take actions to rescue and care of animals.
