A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE "TITLE VI NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY AND PLAN FOR SUB-RECIPIENTS" AS REQUIRED BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCAL AGENCY PROGRAM DATED JANUARY 2018; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City"), through Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT"), is in the process of acquiring Local Agency Program ("LAP") Re-Certification; and

WHEREAS, FDOT is the steward of federal funding and is responsible for oversight of funded projects on behalf of the Federal Highway Administration; and

WHEREAS, LAP certification is a requirement for requesting funding by the FDOT for the development, design, and construction of transportation facilities; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the requirements of the recertification process, the City must obtain approval from the City Council and implement a Citywide Title VI/Non-discriminatory plan which complies with all federal regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has recommended that the City Council adopt the "Title VI/Nondiscrimination Policy and Plan for Sub-Recipients" as required by the Florida Department of Transportation's Local Agency Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.
