

RESOLUTION No. 11 – 04

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MICROSOFT FOR THE PROVISION OF PREMIER SUPPORT SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000.00 FOR ONE YEAR OF SERVICE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral relies heavily on Microsoft products for servers, workstations, databases, e-mail, the website and office productivity tools; and

WHEREAS, Microsoft Premier Support service provides expertise on any Microsoft product seven days a week, 24-hours per day; and

WHEREAS, Microsoft is a sole-source provider of these services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Doral purchasing and procurement Ordinance #2004-03, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council waive the competitive procurement process and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Microsoft for the provision of Premier Support services in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 for one year of service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby waives the competitive procurement process and authorizes the City manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Microsoft for the provision of Premier Support services in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 for one year of service.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


