

**RESOLUTION No. 09 – 50**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA APPROVING THE U.S. SOUTHERN COMMAND RIGHT-OF-WAY DEDICATION OF N.W. 33<sup>RD</sup> STREET FROM N.W. 97<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO THEORETICAL N.W. 92<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, as part of the requirements for the approval of the T-Plat submitted by U.S. Southern Command Headquarters, the City of Doral requested the dedication of the two segments of N.W. 33<sup>rd</sup> Street from N.W. 97<sup>th</sup> Avenue to theoretical N.W. 92<sup>nd</sup> Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council approve the U.S. Southern Command right-of-way (ROW) dedication of road segments stated in the above “whereas” clause.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Doral hereby approves the U.S. Southern Command right-of-way (ROW) dedication of the two segments of N.W. 33<sup>rd</sup> Street from N.W. 97<sup>th</sup> Avenue to theoretical N.W. 92<sup>nd</sup> Avenue; and

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
