

RESOLUTION No. 09 – 14

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SPECIALTY VEHICLES, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF A BIODIESEL FUEL TROLLEY AS A REPLACEMENT FOR THE EXISTING GAS ENGINE CITY OF DORAL TROLLEY AT A COST OF \$15,000.00 PLUS \$1,250.00 PER MONTH FOR LEASE INCREASE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in seeking to mitigate the effects of traffic congestion and to provide alternate modes of travel within the limits of Doral, the City Council created the Doral Trolley service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral currently has two Trolleys one of which operates on a diesel engine and the other on a gas fuel engine; and

WHEREAS, replacing the gas engine vehicle will provide the City with an additional diesel engine which would use biodiesel fuel and which is known to have fewer maintenance issues; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Specialty Vehicles, Inc., for the provision of a biodiesel fuel trolley as a replacement for the existing gas engine City of Doral trolley at a cost of \$15,000.00 to lease and \$1,250.00 per month for lease increase.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Specialty Vehicles, Inc., for the provision of a biodiesel fuel trolley as a replacement for the existing gas engine City of

Doral trolley at a cost of \$15,000.00 to lease and \$1,250.00 per month for lease increase

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
