

RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 122

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO EXPEND FEDERAL EARMARKED FUNDS FOR
THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) NEW TROLLEY FROM SPECIALTY
VEHICLES, INC.; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, during the August 2010 Council Meeting, the City Council approved the implementation of two (2) new trolley routes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Doral was also granted a \$475,000.00 federal appropriation to implement Route 3 and, in December 2010, the City Council authorized an Interlocal Agreement with South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) to obligate these funds; and

WHEREAS, these funds are obligated to be spent on the implementation of the third trolley route; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to expend federal earmarked funds for the purchase of one (1) new trolley from Specialty Vehicles, Inc., a sole source vendor for the Classic American Trolley used by the Doral Transit System.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to expend federal earmarked funds for the purchase of one (1) new trolley from Specialty Vehicles, Inc., a sole source vendor for the Classic American Trolley used by the Doral Transit System.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilman Boria who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Rodriguez and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


