

RESOLUTION No. 16-34

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AWARDED REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS #2016-42 "YOUTH SAND VOLLEYBALL PROGRAM MANAGEMENT" TO DORAL VOLLEYBALL ACADEMY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DORAL VOLLEYBALL ACADEMY FOR THE PROVISION OF YOUTH SAND VOLLEYBALL PROGRAM MANAGEMENT FOR A PERIOD OF TWO (2) YEARS WITH AN ADDITIONAL ONE (1) YEAR RENEWAL FOR A TOTAL OF THREE (3) YEARS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the "City") issued Request For Proposal #2016-42 "Youth Sand Volleyball Program Management" (the "RFP"), for which the City received one (1) submittal by the December 22, 2015 at 11:00a.m. deadline with the firm meeting the required criteria; and

WHEREAS, based on a Three Hundred (300) Total Point System, the firm was scored two hundred and fifty-six (256) points; and

WHEREAS, the committee determined that Doral Volleyball Academy ("DVA") was a responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the City Council award the RFP to DVA and authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with DVA for the provision youth sand volleyball program management for a period of two (2) years with the option for an additional one (1) year renewal for a total of three (3) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Award. The RFP for Youth Sand Volleyball Program Management for the City's Parks and Recreation Department is hereby awarded to Doral Volleyball Academy.

Section 3. Authorization to Procure Services. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with DVA on such terms and condition as may be appropriate to protect and further the interests of the City for this matter. This Authorization does not create or confer any rights to DVA.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilmember Ruiz who moved its adoption.
