## **RESOLUTION No. 07-60**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE "ADOPT-A-STREET" PROGRAM LITTER REMOVAL AGREEMENT WITH DORAL CONSERVATORY & SCHOOL OF ARTS TO PERFORM LITTER-REMOVAL ACTIVITIES AND LANDSCAPING EFFORTS ALONG N.W. 112<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE FROM N.W. 25<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO N.W. 33<sup>RD</sup> STREET AND N.W. 29<sup>TH</sup> STREET FROM N.W. 112<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO N.W. 109<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral, through Resolution #05-12, established an "Adopt-A-Street" Program permitting local organizations, private corporations and volunteer groups to beautify City maintained roads through litter-removal activities and landscaping efforts; and

WHEREAS; Doral Conservatory & School of Arts wishes to adopt N.W. 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue from N.W. 25<sup>th</sup> Street to N.W. 33<sup>rd</sup> Street and N.W. 29<sup>th</sup> Street from N.W. 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue to N.W. 109<sup>th</sup> Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that Council ratify the "Adopt-A-Street" Program Litter Removal Agreement between the City of Doral and Doral Conservatory & School of Arts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
