A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR COMMAND STAFF POLICE VEHICLES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$19,415.00, VIA THE STATE OF FLORIDA AGREEMENT WITH GARBER CHEVROLET WHICH WAS PREVIOUSLY APPROVED THRU RESOLUTION NO. 15-66; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT SUBJECT TO APPROVAL AS TO FORM AND LEGAL SUFFICIENCY BY THE CITY ATTORNEY: PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department is requesting to expend additional funds for 2 Command Staff (Tahoe) police vehicles from Garber Chevrolet via the State of Florida Agreement with Garber Chevrolet which was previously approved thru Resolution No. 15-66; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Garber Chevrolet to expend additional funds for 2 Command Staff (Tahoe) police vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$19,415.00; and

WHEREAS, Staff further requests that this agreement be based on the agreement between Garber Chevrolet and the State of Florida which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V of the City Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are confirmed, adopted, and

incorporated herein and made a part of this reference.

Section 2. Approval. Pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City Code of Ordinances, the procurement of the Vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$19,415.00 via the State of Florida Agreement with Garber Chevrolet is hereby approved.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement and other contractual documents, subject to approval as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney, as may be necessary to procure the Vehicles under the State of Florida Agreement with Garber Chevrolet, and to expend additional funds in furtherance thereof in amounts not to exceed 19,415.00 previously approved thru Resolution No. 15-66.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager and City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such further action as may be necessary to implement the purpose and provision of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
