

RESOLUTION NO. 14-180

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE EXISTING ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND THE CORRADINO GROUP, INC. TO DECEMBER 31, 2014; APPROVING A WORK ORDER BETWEEN THE CITY OF DORAL AND THE CORRADINO GROUP, INC. TO PROCEED WITH THE VANDERBILT PARK TRAFFIC CALMING STUDY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,880.52; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral (the “City”) Public Works Department (“PWD”) has received numerous complaints regarding extensive speeding and cut-through traffic complaints within the Vanderbilt Park residential area; and

WHEREAS, in March of 2014, the PWD contacted the residents of Vanderbilt Park via a survey to obtain feedback as to whether the majority of the residents shared these concerns in order to have the PWD study the Vanderbilt Park area; and

WHEREAS, the overwhelm consensus (90% of the completed surveys) is that the Vanderbilt Park residents are concerned with the cut through traffic and excessive vehicular speeding within their community; and

WHEREAS, the Corradino Group, Inc., is a prequalified provider of professional services selected in accordance with Consultant Competitive Negotiation Act requirements and approved by the City Council in September 2011; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council approve a contract extension with The Corradino Group, Inc. under the existing term and conditions to December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council approve the Work Order with The Corradino Group, Inc., to proceed with the Vanderbilt Park Traffic Calming Study; in an amount not to exceed \$30,880.52.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2. Approval. The existing Architectural and Engineering contract between the City of Doral and The Corradino Group, Inc. under the existing terms and conditions to December 31, 2014; and the Work Order between the City of Doral and The Corradino Group, Inc. for engineering services for the Vanderbilt Park Traffic Calming Study; in an amount not to exceed \$30,880.52, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Work Order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such actions as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Ruiz who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Cabrera and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The City of Doral authorizes the firm of The Corradino Group to perform the engineering and permitting services for the Vanderbilt Park Traffic Calming Study as of the date of this Work Order. The work should be performed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the City of Doral Engineering and Architectural Services Contract Master Agreement dated November 7, 2011, and the attached Proposal submitted by your firm for the above referenced project.

The scope of the project will be as described in the attached proposal. The schedule requires the work to be performed within 150 calendar days after issuance of the notice to proceed.

The performance of services associated with this Work Order will be executed on a time and material basis with a not to exceed amount of \$30,880.52.

If you fail to execute said Work Order and begin work within ten (10) days the City of Doral will be entitled to disqualify the Proposal, and revoke the award.
