## RESOLUTION No. 16-70

## A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN EXTENSION TO THE CURRENT AGREEMENT WITH BEHAVIOR LINKS, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF A SPECIAL NEEDS SUMMER CAMP FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) ADDITIONAL ONE (1) YEAR TERM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED $\$ 25,000.00$; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the first summer camp for children with special needs (the "Camp") was held during the 2015 summer break by Behavior Links, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Camp was a major success with demonstrated positive results for participants; and

WHEREAS, the City does not currently have the facilities to host such a Camp at City Parks; and

WHEREAS, Behavior Links, Inc. has secured a facility within the City to host such a Camp until Doral Legacy Park can be completed; and

WHEREAS, Staff has recommended that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate an extension to the current agreement for the summer camp for children with special needs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval \& Authorization. The City Council hereby approves an extension to the current agreement with Behavior Links, Inc. for the provision of a special needs summer for a period of one (1) additional one (1) year term.

Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager and the City Attorney are hereby authorized to take such action as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
