**PUBLIC NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of North Miami, Florida proposes to adopt the following ordinance:

- (1) AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE, SUBJECT TO THE BOND REFERENDUM HEREIN PROVIDED FOR, OF GENERAL OBLIGATION INDEBTEDNESS IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT (WITHOUT REGARD TO ORIGINAL ISSUE DISCOUNT OR PREMIUM) NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE MILLION DOLLARS (\$155,000,000) FOR THE CITY OF NORTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, FOR PROVIDING FUNDS TO FINANCE THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION AND IMPROVEMENT OF VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, PAYABLE FROM THE FULL FAITH, CREDIT AND AD VALOREM TAXING POWER OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR AND CALLING A BOND REFERENDUM OF THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR OFFICIAL BALLOTS; PROVIDING FOR BOND REFERENDUM PROCEDURES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Public Hearings for the Ordinance was held before the Council on **Tuesday, January 9, 2018, and Second reading will be held on February 13, 2018, at 7:00 pm.** in the Council Chambers of North Miami City Hall, 2nd Floor, 776 N.E. 125th Street, North Miami, Florida 33161.

The public may inspect the proposed Ordinance in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of North Miami, said office being located in the City Hall, 776 N.E. 125th Street. Interested parties may appear at the meeting and be heard in respect to the proposed Ordinance. Should any person desire to appeal any decision of the City Council with respect to any matter to be considered at this meeting, that person must insure that a verbatim records of the proceedings is made including all testimony and evidence upon which any appeal may be based (Chapter 286.0105, F.S.)

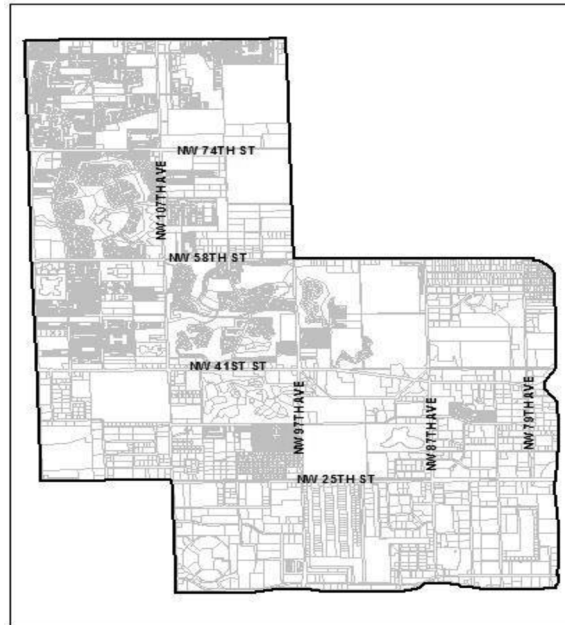
