A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-322 OF THE CITY CODE, ADOPTING THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN BARTOW FORD AND THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES AND FLORIDA FIRE CHIEF'S ASSOCIATION WHICH WAS COMPETITIVELY ENTERED INTO IN A MANNER SIMILAR TO THAT SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE V, OF THE CITY CODE FOR THE PROVISION OF SIX (6) POLICE VEHICLES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$175,985.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Police Department seeks to purchase six (6) police vehicles to replace existing vehicles that have exceeded mileage; and

WHEREAS, Bartow Ford has an existing contract with the State of Florida (Contract #11-19-0907) which was competitively procured for the provision of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City Code, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council adopt the existing agreement between Bartow Ford and the Florida Sheriff's Association, Florida Association of Counties and Florida Fire Chief's Association which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of the City Code for the provision of six (6) Police vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$175,985.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 2-322 of the City Code, the City Council hereby adopts the existing agreement between Bartow Ford and the Florida Sheriff's Association, Florida Association of Counties, and Florida Fire Chief's Association which was competitively entered into in a manner similar to that set forth in Chapter 2, Article V, of

the City Code for the provision six (6) Police vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$175,985.00.
