

RESOLUTION No. 09 – 15

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,168.00; RECOGNIZING THAT MARLIN ENGINEERING, INC. IS A CITY OF DORAL PRE-QUALIFIED VENDOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City of Doral Resolution #07-89 pre-qualified ten (10) vendors, including Marlin Engineering, Inc. to provide services needed for City Projects including design and construction administration services; and

WHEREAS, the approved roadway capital improvement program identified two sections of road for resurfacing that will require design and construction administration services; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Marlin Engineering, Inc. for the provision of design and construction administration services in an amount not exceed \$40,168.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Council of the City of Doral Florida hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Marlin Engineering, Inc. for the provision of design and construction administration services in an amount not exceed \$40,168.00.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
