

RESOLUTION No. 23-126

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, APPROVING A WORK ORDER WITH H & R PAVING, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF MILLING, RESURFACING, AND STRIPING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES ALONG CITY ROADWAY SECTIONS 25739, 27281, 25825, AND 27278 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$136,365.35, WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY FOR ANY UNFORSEEN CONDITIONS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE WORK ORDER AND EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2022, the City of Doral (“City”) issued and advertised Request for Qualification No. 2022-13 “Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping Construction Services” (the “RFQ”); and

WHEREAS, a recommendation was made by the evaluation committee to award the RFQ to the top four (4) ranked firms: H&J Asphalt, Inc., H&R Paving, Inc., Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc., and General Asphalt; and

WHEREAS, on August 9, 2022, pursuant to Resolution No. 22-144, the City Council awarded continuing construction contracts with the four (4) top-ranked firms listed above thereby establishing a pre-qualified pool of construction firms for milling, resurfacing, and striping construction services (“Services”); and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department (“PWD”) is in need of a firm to provide Services along City Roadway Sections 25739, 27281, 25825, and 27278; and

WHEREAS, the PWD requested a proposal from the pre-qualified pool of contractors for said Services, and H&R Paving, Inc., was deemed the lowest bidder

having provided a proposal in an amount not to exceed \$136,365.35, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions; and

WHEREAS, the continuing construction contract between H&R Paving, Inc. and the City was procured through the publicly advertised RFQ referenced above; and

WHEREAS, City staff respectfully requests that the Mayor and the City Councilmembers approve Work Order No. 7 with H&R Paving, Inc., a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", for the provision of Milling, Resurfacing, and Striping of City Roadway Sections 25739, 27281, 25825, and 27278 in an amount not to exceed \$136,365.35, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions; and

WHEREAS, funding for Work Order No. 7 is available in the Public Works Transportation Fund Account, Account Num. 101.80005.500633.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made part hereof by this reference.

Section 2. Approval. The City Council hereby approves Work Order No. 7 with H&R Paving, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$136,365.35, which includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen conditions, a copy of which is attached hereto as

Exhibit "A", together with such non-material changes as may be acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Manager is authorized to execute the work order and expend budgeted funds on behalf of the City.

Section 4. Implementation. The City Manager is authorized to execute Work Order No. 7 and to expend the budgeted funds to implement the terms and conditions of said Work Order on behalf of the City.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Vice Mayor Pineyro who moved its adoption.
