A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, SITTING AS THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74, "MISCELLANEOUS AND SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS," BY UPDATING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE REGULATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in 2007, the City of Doral (the "City") adopted its own Land Development Code of Ordinances (the "Code"), after having depended on Miami-Dade County's land development regulations in the initial years following incorporation; and

WHEREAS, the Code included, in part, regulations that pertained to the sale of alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, portions of the alcoholic beverage regulations incorporated into the

Code were directly taken from the Miami-Dade County Code, which at the time had not

been updated in over ten years; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update and improve the City's alcoholic beverages regulations as provided in the attached ordinance found in Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council believe that adoption and implementation of the proposed Ordinance will promote the general public health, safety, and welfare, and be in the best interest of, the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA SITTING AS THE LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY THAT:

Section 1. Recitals. The above Recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part of hereof by this reference.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; Words in <u>underscored</u> type are additions. <u>Section 2.</u> <u>Recommendation.</u> The proposed change to the City's Land Development Code, as shown in Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein and made a part hereof by this reference, is consistent with the City's Comprehensive Plan. Therefore, it is recommended that the requested amendment be approve.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
