## **ORDINANCE No. 2018-05**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT AND INCREASE OF THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET OF THE CITY OF DORAL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary to adjust certain budget line items in the City's General Fund for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 (the "Budget") in order to reflect the land purchase of the vacant lot located on the Southeast Corner of 66 Street and 102 Avenue, Folio number 35-3017-001-0660; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Recitals. The above recitals are true, correct, and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Budget Amendment. Pursuant to Article IV, Section 4.06 of the City Charter a supplemental appropriation is being made from the Undesignated and Unrestricted Fund Balance of the General Fund, and the following budget amendment are hereby approved: The Fiscal Year 2017-2018 General Fund Budget is hereby amended and increased in the amount of \$8,100,000 by the inclusion of and appropriation to the following line item budget:

<u>Public Works – Capital-Land</u> – Account 001.80005.500610: \$8,100,000.00

As a result of this amendment request, the City's General Fund Budget increases to a total of \$87,411,419.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Implementation.</u> The City Manager, City Clerk, and City Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to implement the provisions of this Ordinance and to take any and all necessary administrative actions as may be appropriate by their position to execute the purpose of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this Ordinance but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

<u>Section 5.</u> Conflicts. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, resolution or parts of resolutions, in conflict herewith, are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption on second reading.
