 - A. Update: 2019-2020 Afterschool Program

The board discussed the possibility of using more parks such as going to Morgan Levy Park and playing golf there, as well as trying to incorporate playing tennis. Ms. Erin Weislow stated that the Parks Department will be more than willing to cooperate with PP4K. Lieutenant Munecas advised the board that he will be meeting with the school counselors at Eugenia B. Thomas to get things going as soon as possible.

B. Update: Back to School Night/ National Night Out Event Recap and Backpack Giveaway Ms. Erin Weislow provided a recap of the event. Overall, the event went extremely well. The Directors and parents were happy. Director Ruiz brought up the quality of the bags, as well as the amount of supplies included in the bags, in comparison to last year. Laura Medina, Parks and Recreation, addressed the board and explained that the supplies were donated by Covanta, and perhaps there was not an understanding of the quality of the supplies. The board agreed that in the future, the sponsors should provide funds and the City will purchase the supplies. By consensus, the board requested a count of the damaged backpacks and the number of sponsors (with the amounts given) for the next meeting.

Discussion ensued on the remaining backpacks after the Friday deadline. Motion to give the backpacks that are left after all the pre-registration bags have been picked up to Lt. Munecas for distribution to the less fortunate kids at the public schools made by Director Ruiz and seconded by Director Canchola. By consensus, motion passes unanimously.

C. Discussion: Sponsorship Appreciation Event

Director Ruiz addressed the board and suggested to have a Sponsor Appreciation Event sometime in January 2020 to thank all the companies and individuals that have helped PP4K. By consensus, the board agreed and will begin to work on the details.
