## RESOLUTION No. 11 – 132

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT REQUIREMENTS AND ADOPTING THE TERMS OF THE EXISTING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT AND PHYSIO-CONTROL, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF AUTOMATED ELECTRONIC DEFIBRILLATORS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000.00 DURING FISCAL YEAR 2011-2012; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral seeks to make Automated Electronic Defibrillators (AEDs) readily available to our first responders; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Purchasing and Procurement Ordinance #2004-03, Sec. 12-9, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council waive the competitive procurement requirements and adopt the terms of the existing agreement between the Miami-Dade County Fire Department and Physio-Control, Inc. for the provision of AEDs in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF DORAL, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Doral, Florida hereby waives the competitive procurement requirements and adopt the terms of the existing agreement between the Miami-Dade County Fire Department and Physio-Control, Inc. for the provision of AEDs in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00.
