A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MIAMI-DADE COUNTY GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION FLEET MANAGEMENT DIVISION FOR THE PROVISION OF PATROL VEHICLE FUEL IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEED \$370,000.00; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade County General Services Administration (GSA), Fleet Management Division is a City of Doral registered vendor and has been providing fuel services to all City vehicles since January 2005 pursuant to Resolution No. 05-02; and

WHEREAS, this division has provided fuel services as a way to lower overall governmental spending within the boundaries of Miami-Dade County by providing said services at a wholesale price which is always below market; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Miami-Dade County GSA, Fleet Management Division for the provision of patrol vehicle fuel in an amount not to exceed \$370,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Miami-Dade County GSA, Fleet Management Division for the provision of patrol vehicle fuel in an amount not to exceed \$370,000.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
