## RESOLUTION No. 09 - 140

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A SECURE OUR SCHOOLS (SOS) GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$405,144.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF INCORPORATING FIVE (5) SCHOOLS WITHIN THE CITY'S VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE AWARD OVER A TWO-YEAR PERIOD; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral has been notified that it will receive funds from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Secure Our Schools (SOS) grant program; and

WHEREAS, the SOS award will assist with the procurement of school safety resources and the opportunity to establish and enhance a variety of school safety equipment and/or programs; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to accept the SOS grant from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$405,144.00 for the provision of incorporating five (5) schools within the City's video surveillance system; and

WHEREAS, Staff further requests that Council authorize the City Manager to expend matching funds for the SOS award over a two (2)-year period.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:
