RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 12

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TRANSFER \$1,298.00 FROM WITHIN THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT BUDGET FOR FY 10-11 TO COVER THE COSTS OF PURCHASING ONE CONVENTIONAL AND ONE HYBRID VEHICLE FOR THE USE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Doral Public Works Department budgeted for the purchase of two new vehicles to replace aging vehicles in the fleet; and

WHEREAS, after evaluating pricing and capabilities, Staff has determined that it is best to purchase one hybrid and one conventional vehicle in keeping with the City's green initiatives; and

WHEREAS, the current budget for the purchase of these vehicles is \$52,000.00 but the total price of the vehicles if \$53,298.00; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City Manager to transfer \$1,298.00 from within the Public Works Department budget for FY 10-11 to cover the costs of purchasing one conventional and one hybrid vehicle for the use of the Public Works Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to transfer \$1,298.00 from within the Public Works Department budget for FY 10-11 to cover the costs of purchasing one conventional and one hybrid vehicle for the use of the Public Works Department.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
