## **RESOLUTION No. 08 – 125**

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH URS CORPORATION SOUTHERN, INC. (URS) FOR THE PROVISION OF STORMWATER MASTER PLAN UPDATE AND REVISIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$54,000.00; RECOGNIZING THAT URS IS A PRE-QUALIFIED CITY OF DORAL VENDOR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City of Doral Resolution #07-89 pre-qualified ten (10) vendors, including URS Corporation Southern, Inc. (URS), to provide different engineering and architectural services; and

WHEREAS, an immediate City Project is the updating and revision of the City of Doral Stormwater Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, based on qualifications, expertise and previous experience, Staff believes that URS is best suited to provide the above-referenced service to the City of Doral; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the City manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with URS for the provision of Stormwater Master Plan update and revisions in an amount not to exceed \$54,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The City Council of the City of Doral hereby authorizes the City manager to negotiate and enter into an agreement with URS for the provision of Stormwater Master Plan update and revisions in an amount not to exceed \$54,000.00.

**Section 2**. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
