

RESOLUTION NO. 12 – 149

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE RELOCATION OF ETHERNET SERVICES TO THE NEW PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY AND REPLACEMENT OF SERVICE AT MORGAN LEVY PARK IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000.00 PER YEAR FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE (5) YEARS PLUS A ONE-TIME COST NOT TO EXCEED \$7,000.00 FOR INSTALLATION AND SERVICE RELOCATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City's wide area network includes the Government Center, the Police Building, Morgan Levy Park, Doral Meadow Park, and the NAP of the Americas; and

WHEREAS, Staff respectfully requests that the City Council authorize the relocation of Ethernet services to the new Public Works Facility and replacement of service at Morgan Levy Park in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00 per year for a period of five (5) years plus a one-time cost not to exceed \$7,000.00 for installation and service relocation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DORAL AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the relocation of Ethernet services to the new Public Works Facility and replacement of service at Morgan Levy Park in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00 per year for a period of five (5) years plus a one-time cost not to exceed \$7,000.00 for installation and service relocation.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


